The Heritage II Digital dynamic mattress replacement system provides optimal therapy for the prevention and treatment of pressure ulcers in any care environment. Featuring an intuitive digital control panel the Heritage II Digital is easy to operate and ensures high quality care for patients up to a very high risk



Key zoning and therapy to address patient needs

The Heritage II Digital is constructed of deep 8" cells, in a cell-on-cell design and provides dual therapy modes - **Alternating** and **Static** for patients up to 255kg/40 stone.

Specific zones of the mattress address the key comfort and care needs of each patient. **Static head cells** provide support and stability, the **lower leg zone** provides lower residual interface pressure in this highly sensitive area, while dynamic therapy is provided in the main body area.



High quality pressure care for high risk patients

Powered by **dual compressors** the digital power unit of the Heritage II Digital offers a host of key features that deliver high quality pressure care for patients at High to Very High Risk of pressure damage.

Variable cycle times offer the choice of a standard 10 minute cycle or extended periods of 15/20/25/30 minutes, which may be desirable as patients begin to rehabilitate. The system offers both Alternating and Constant Low Pressure therapy modes, while the ability to select the Manual Auto-Detection feature allows patient weight/position to be automatically detected and pressure set accordingly, ensuring optimum patient protection.



Enhanced patient safety and peace of mind

The Heritage II Digital addresses key patient safety issues with an **Auto Lockout** feature which prevents unintentional activation of the control panel and an excellent 48 hour **Transport mode** which provides a security buffer to allow patients to remain on an inflated surface in the event of a power failure.

The **Timed Static mode** automatically returns to Alternating mode safeguarding patients against the risk of pressure damage and sophisticated **audible and visual alarms** provide real peace of mind.

Constant Low Pressure mode allows the mattress to conform closely a patient's body and redistribute body weight over a wider area; this greater patient immersion delivers optimum constant levels of pressure redistribution.
