1 Introduction

These instructions aid the user and/or carer about the safe and efficient use of this product, including assembly, cleaning and maintenance, and operation of the product.

2. Description of product

This Toilet Frame supports clients to give them confidence as they sit & rise, offering support and lessening of strain. It has an adjustable height feature to cater for varying patient requirements. The easy to clip on / clip off seat makes it easy to fit & remove and the partial cutaway provides easy access for personal cleansing. This product is suitable for intensive cleansing.

3. Fitting Instructions

- a) Carefully unpack and check the product to ensure it is complete.
- b) Before use, check for any signs of damage e.g., cracked weld, flaking paint, or parts bent. If any damage is seen, please contact your Supplier.
- c) Remove the pin clips from the legs and safely put to one side.
- **d)** Select the desired height of the frame by gently sliding out each extension leg from the frame.
- e) When the desired height is obtained, refit the pin clips into the appropriate hole ensuring that the pin clips go through each leg and its extension leg and that all legs are set to the same height.
- f) Push the moulded seat onto the frame making sure that it is positioned as centrally as possible.
- g) The frame is now ready for use.



NOTE:

The legs are extended telescopically.



CAUTION:

• Do not attempt to use if the product shows any sign of damage.

4. Cleaning

Use mild detergent with warm water to wipe down the framework and seat on at least a weekly basis or more frequently if required.



CALITION:

- ☐ Abrasive cleaners and/ or abrasive cleaning pads will damage the frame
- If the product is cleaned using a power/ jet wash or industrial washing machines care must be taken since high-pressure water can be penetrative. The frame should not be placed too close to highpressure water jets.
- ☐ After cleaning, ensure that any residual water is removed from the framework as this can lead to permanent rusting of the frame. (Leave frames open in a warm environment for several hours to ensure that all internal moisture evaporates.)
- We cannot offer advice on industrial washing machines with regards to specific machine settings as these will be dependent on the manufacturer's instructions

5. Care and Maintenance

The product should be checked on a regular basis for damage or wear and tear – this includes flaking or cracking of paint. Any signs of damage should be noted and reported to your supplier.

- Defective set up by the user or third parties. Negligent or careless treatment
- Use of unsuitable or unapproved spares or unauthorised alteration.
- The warranty does not extend to consequential costs resulting from fault clearance, loss of earnings or expenses

This in no way affects your statutory rights.

8. Disposal advice

This product must be thoroughly cleaned/sterilised prior to disposal. The product and /or its components are of standard non-hazardous materials therefore can be disposed of without any potential environmental hazards providing that local recycling arrangements are sought and adhered to.

9. Life expectancy

We estimate a life expectancy of 2 years for this product, provided that:

- It is used in strict accordance with the intended use as set out in this
 document.
 - All service and maintenance requirements are met.

The estimated life expectancy can be exceeded if the product is carefully used and properly maintained.
